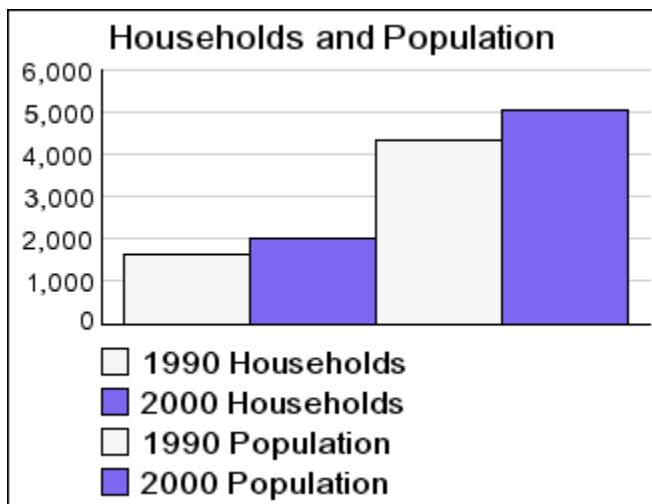

Executive Summary Report with Charts

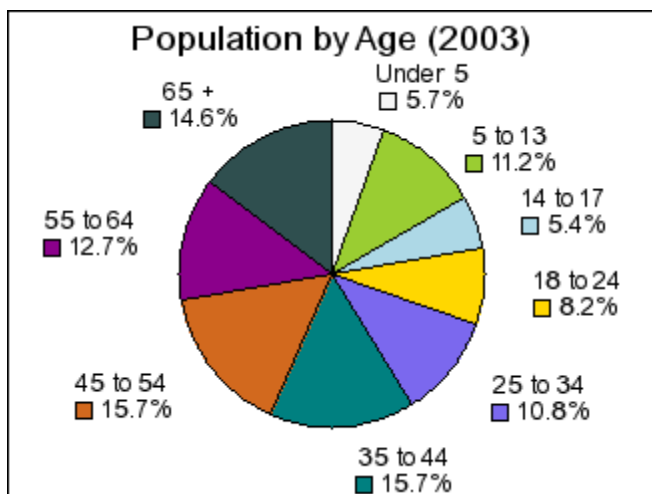
Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **1,678** and changed to **2,060** in 2000, representing a change of **23%**. The household count in 2003 was **2,117** and the household projection for 2008 is **2,210**, a change of **4%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **4,378** and in 2000 it was **5,091**, roughly a **16%** change. The population in 2003 was **5,129** and the projection for 2008 is **5,192** representing a change of **1%**.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **36.4**, and in 2000, it was **39.5**. The median age in 2003 is **40.9** and it is predicted to change in five years to **42.7** years.

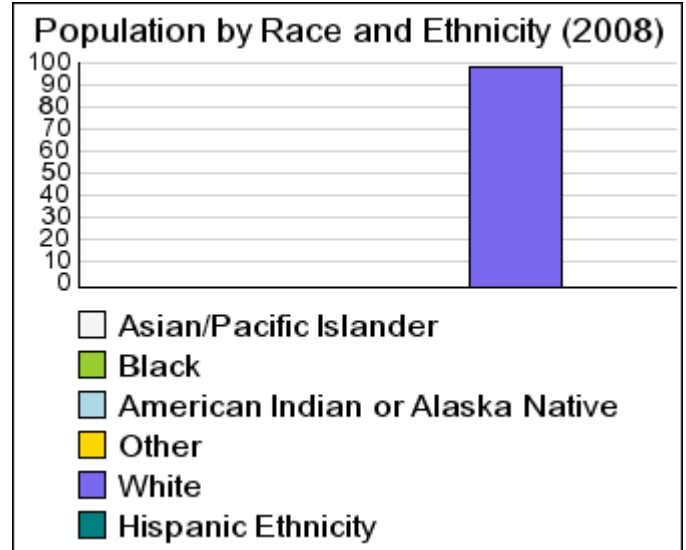
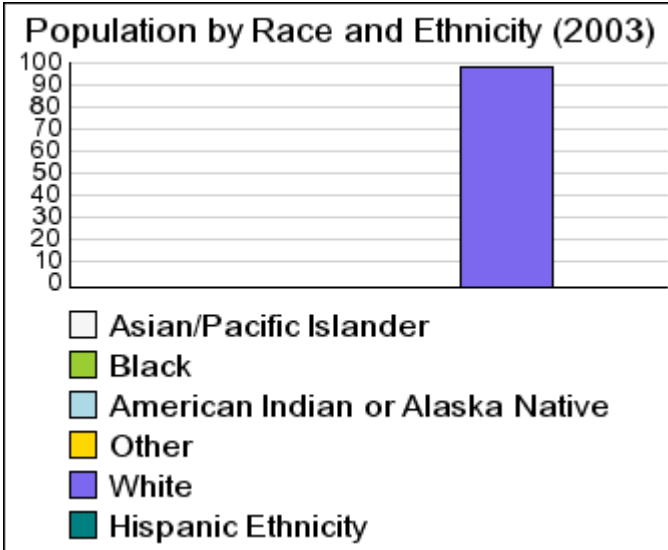
In 2003, females represented **48.9%** of the population with a median age of **42.1** and males represented **51.1%** of the population with a median age of **39.8** years.

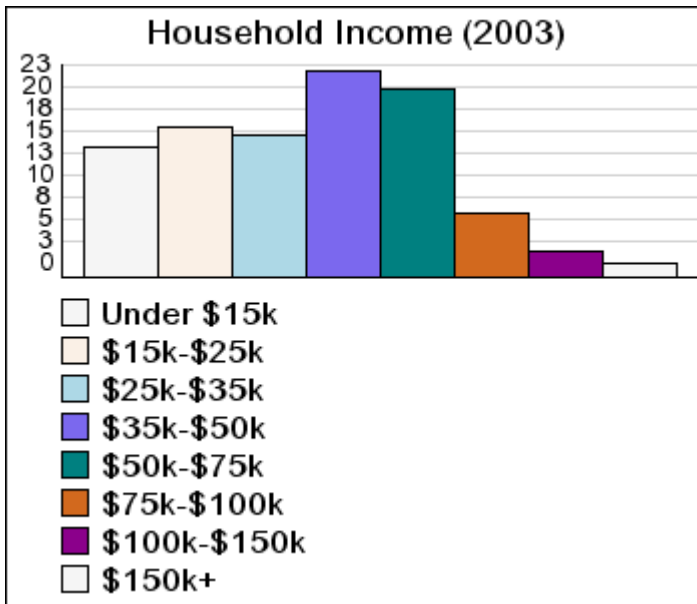
Population by Race/Ethnicity

Households by Income

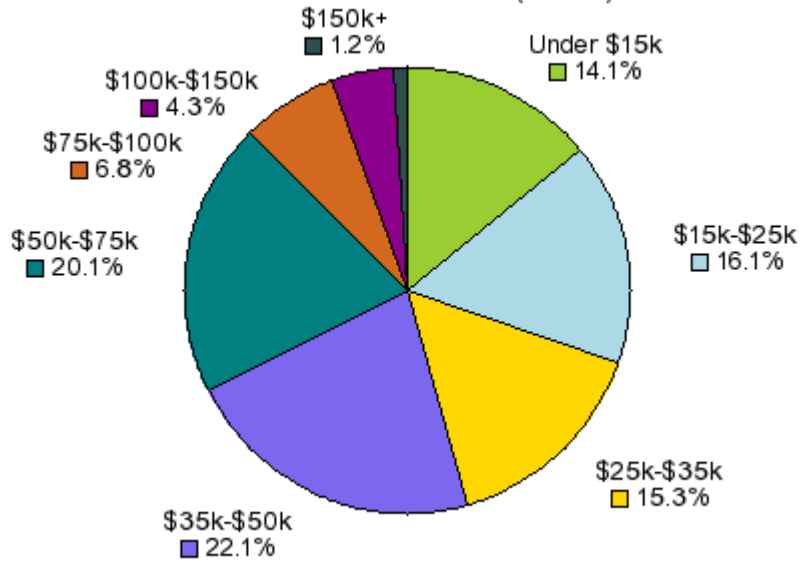

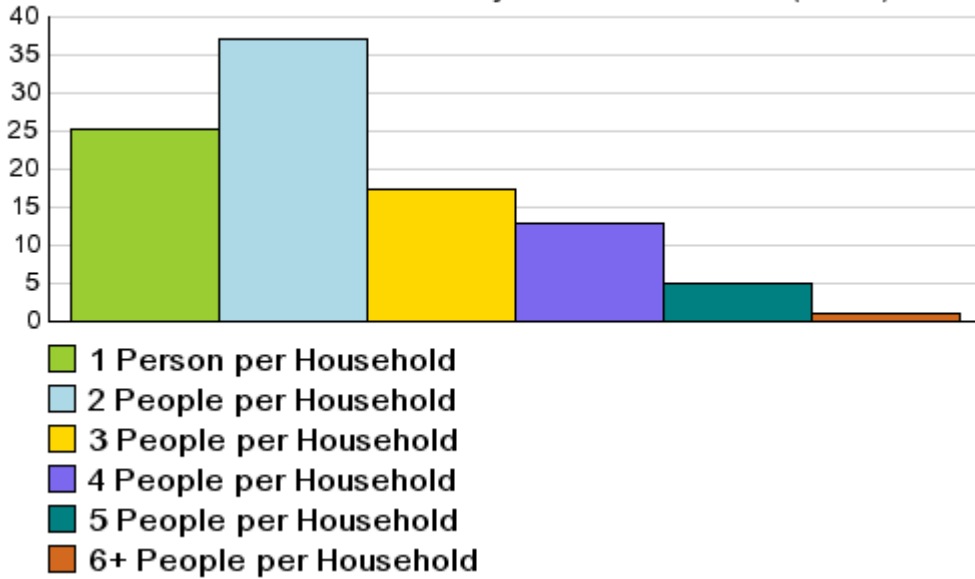

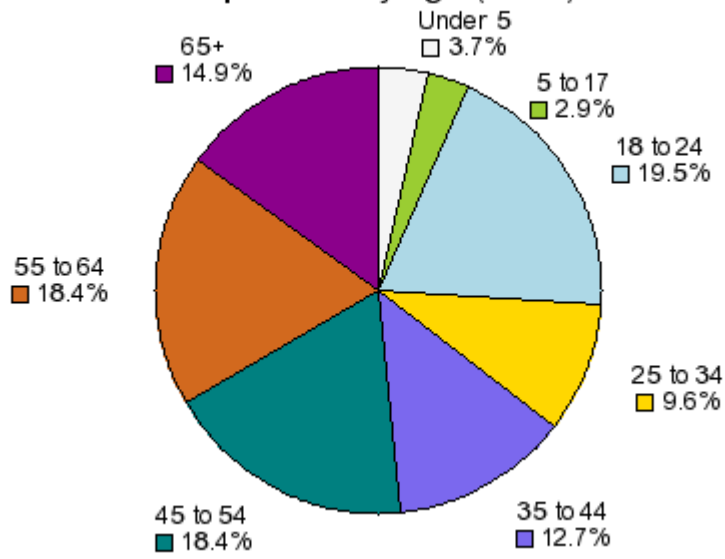
Household Income (2003)



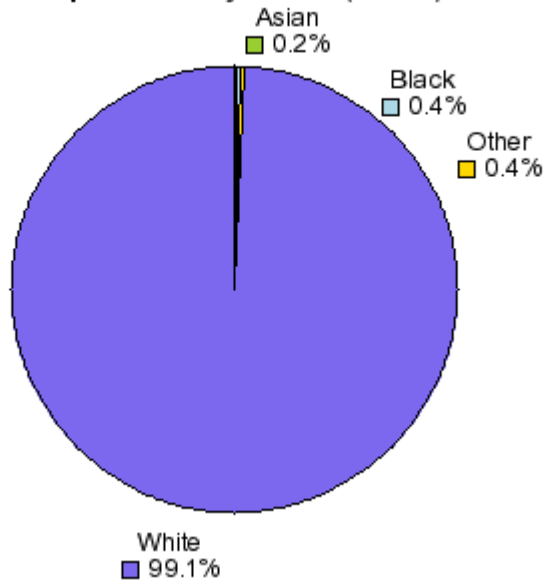
Percent of Households by Persons Per HH (2003)



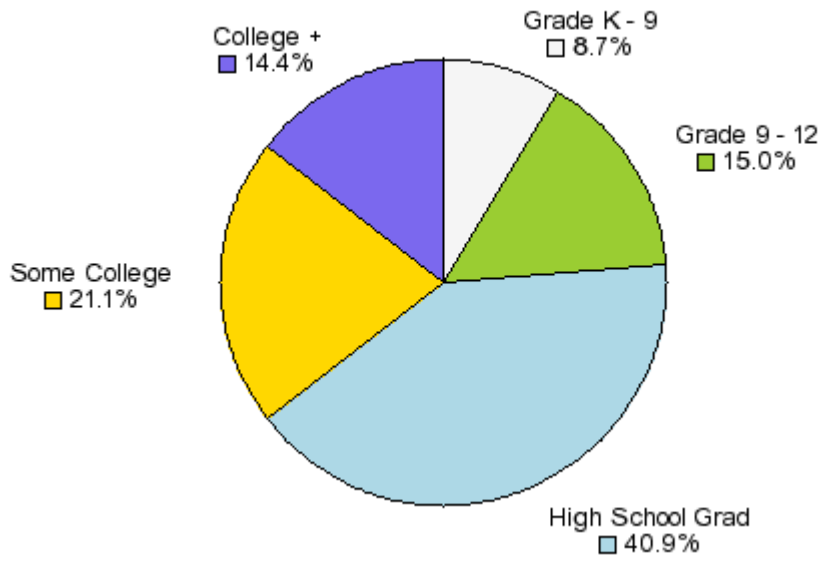
Population by Age (2003)



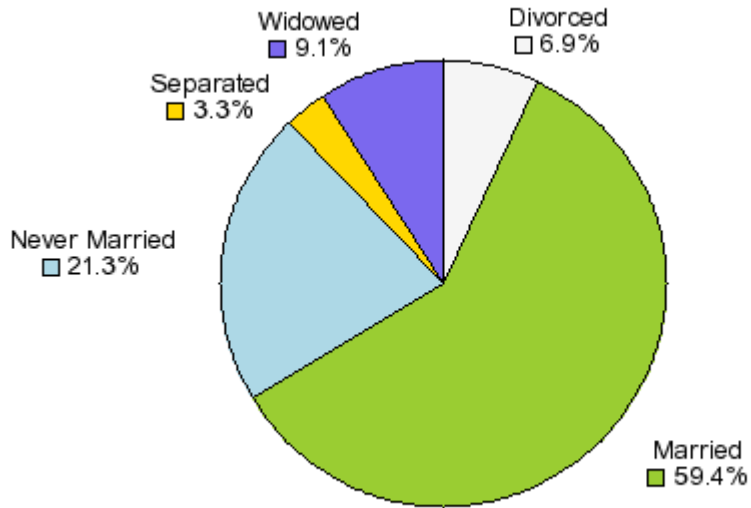
Population by Race (2003)

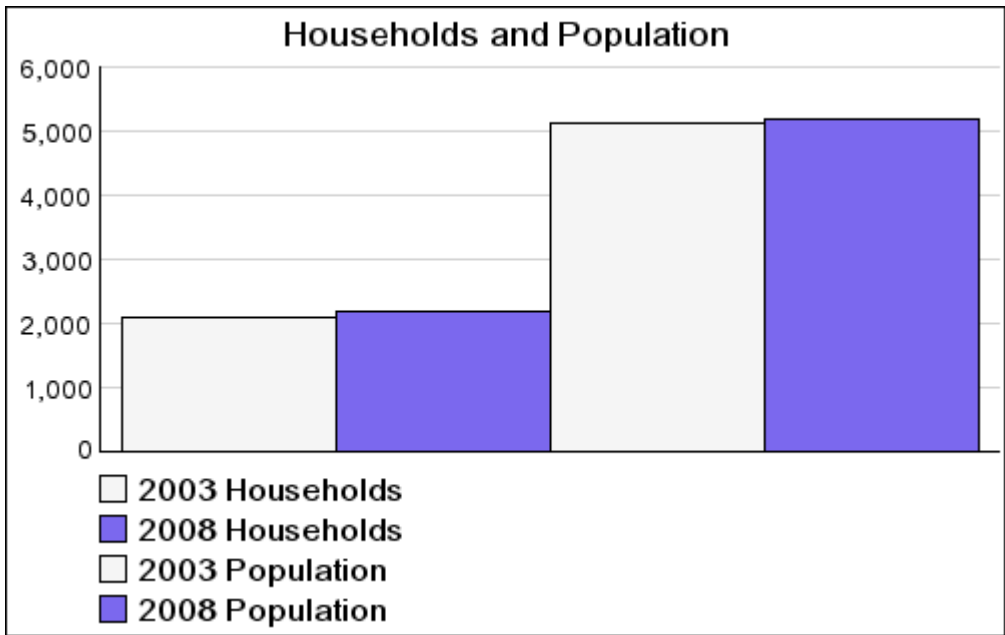


Education (2003)
