

Executive Summary Report with Charts


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **2,813** and changed to **3,528** in 2000, representing a change of **25%**. The household count in 2003 was **3,560** and the household projection for 2008 is **3,611**, a change of **1%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **7,825** and in 2000 it was **9,017**, roughly a **15%** change. The population in 2003 was **8,845** and the projection for 2008 is **8,590** representing a change of **-3%**.

Population by Age




In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **35.2**, and in 2000, it was **38.4**. The median age in 2003 is **39.5** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40.6** years.


In 2003, females represented **52.6**% of the population with a median age of **40.1** and males represented **47.4**% of the population with a median age of **38.8** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity


