## Executive Summary Report with Charts

## Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 7,427 and changed to 9,945 in 2000, representing a change of $\mathbf{3 4 \%}$. The household count in 2003 was $\mathbf{1 0 , 9 3 9}$ and the household projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{1 2 , 5 3 4}$, a change of $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$. The population in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{2 0 , 3 2 5}$ and in 2000 it was 25,627, roughly a $\mathbf{2 6 \%}$ change. The population in 2003 was 27,620 and the projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{3 0 , 6 7 9}$ representing a change of 11\%.

Population by Age


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was $\mathbf{3 4 . 8}$, and in 2000 , it was $\mathbf{3 8 . 8}$. The median age in 2003 is $\mathbf{4 0 . 3}$ and it is predicted to change in five years to 42.1 years.

In 2003, females represented 50.9\% of the population with a median age of 40.7 and males represented $\mathbf{4 9 . 1 \%}$ of the population with a median age of $\mathbf{3 9 . 8}$ years.

In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is $\mathbf{3 5}$ to $\mathbf{4 4}$ years. The age group least represented in this geography is $\mathbf{1 4}$ to $\mathbf{1 7}$ years. The table below sorts age groups by the 2003 Estimate for the Age Groups.
