

Executive Summary Report with Charts


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 7,427 and changed to 9,945 in 2000, representing a change of 34%. The household count in 2003 was 10,939 and the household projection for 2008 is 12,534, a change of 15%. The population in the study area in 1990 was 20,325 and in 2000 it was 25,627, roughly a 26% change. The population in 2003 was 27,620 and the projection for 2008 is 30,679 representing a change of 11%.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34.8**, and in 2000, it was **38.8**. The median age in 2003 is **40.3** and it is predicted to change in five years to **42.1** years.


In 2003, females represented **50.9**% of the population with a median age of **40.7** and males represented **49.1%** of the population with a median age of **39.8** years.

In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is **35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **14 to 17** years. The table below sorts age groups by the 2003 Estimate for the Age Groups.


Population by Race/Ethnicity
