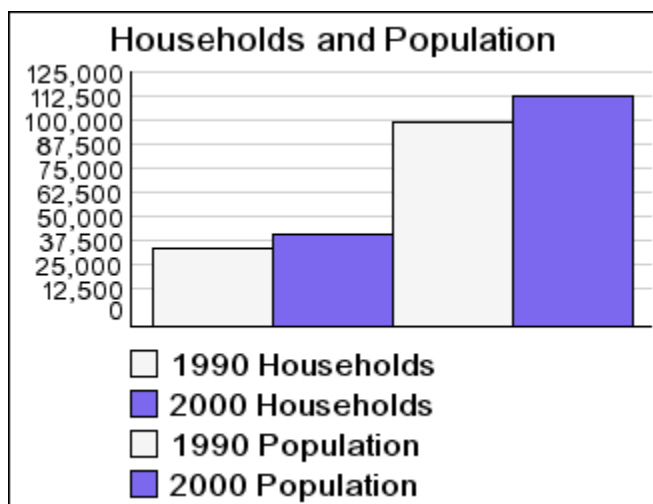

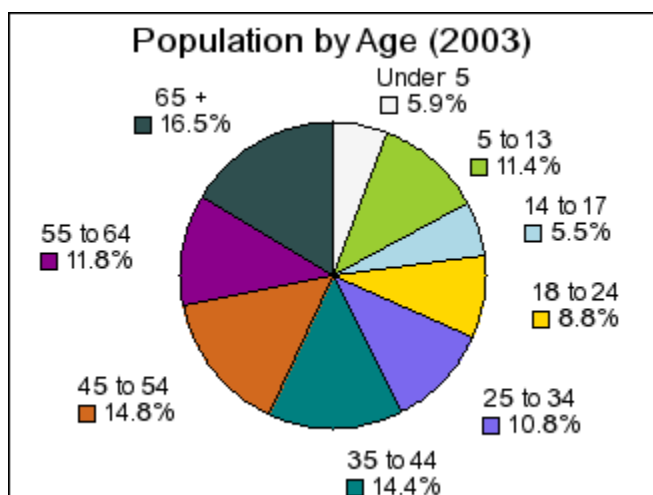
Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **38,488** and changed to **45,558** in 2000, representing a change of **18%**. The household count in 2003 was **47,269** and the household projection for 2008 is **49,980**, a change of **6%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **101,178** and in 2000 it was **114,158**, roughly a **13%** change. The population in 2003 was **116,431** and the projection for 2008 is **119,942** representing a change of **3%**.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **35.9**, and in 2000, it was **39.6**. The median age in 2003 is **40.6** and it is predicted to change in five years to **41.7** years.

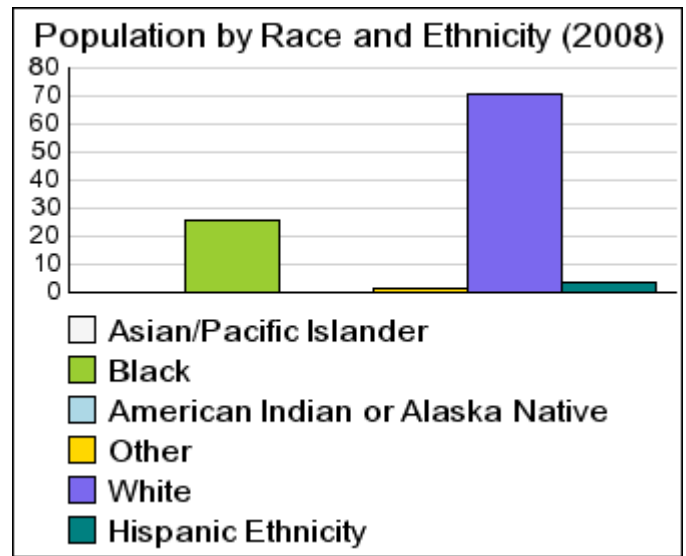
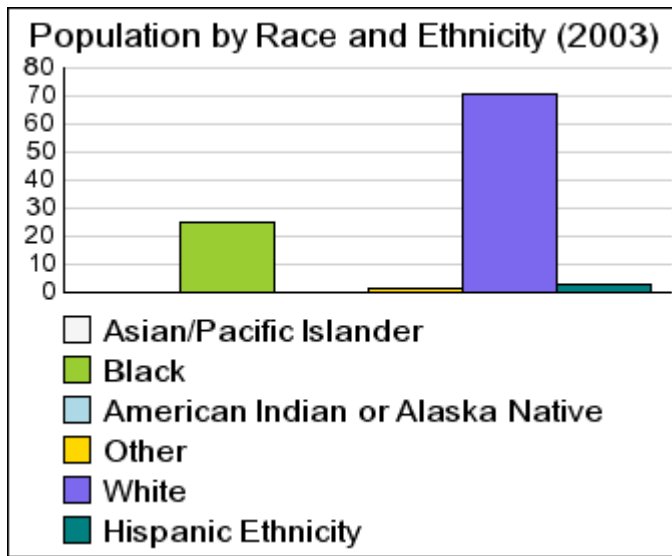
In 2003, females represented **51.4%** of the population with a median age of **41.7** and males represented **48.6%** of the population with a median age of **39.4** years.

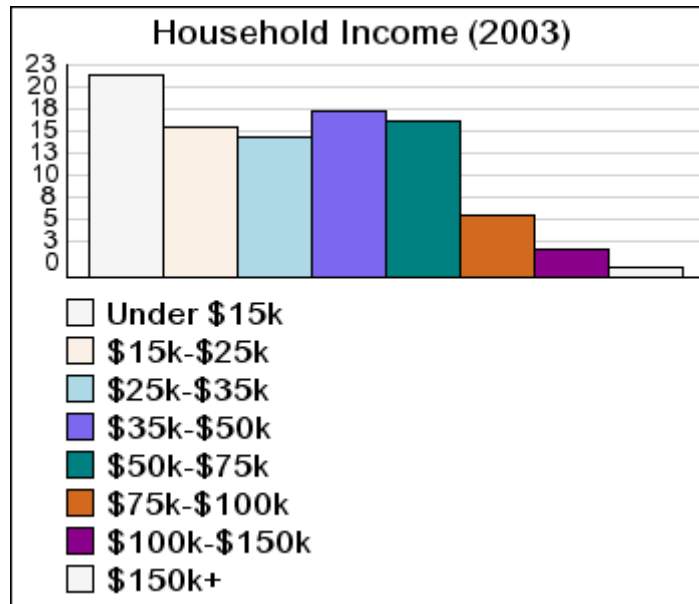
Population by Race/Ethnicity

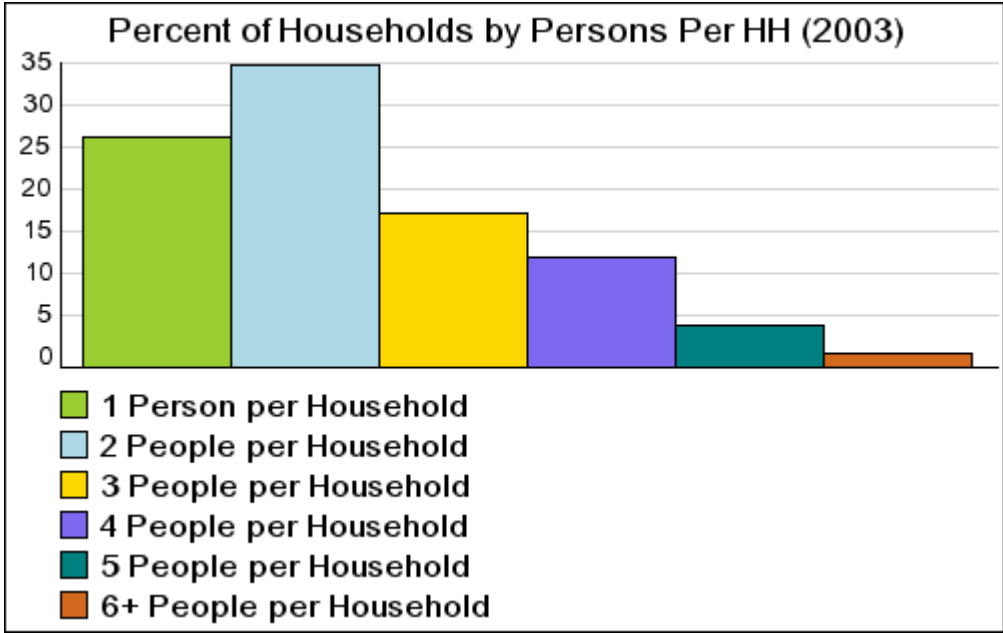
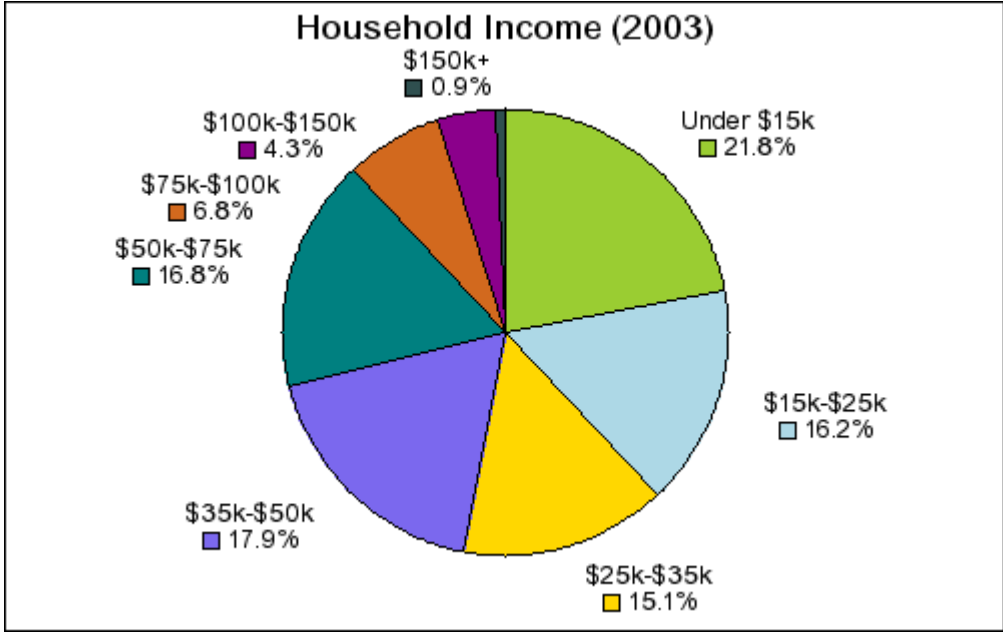
Households by Income



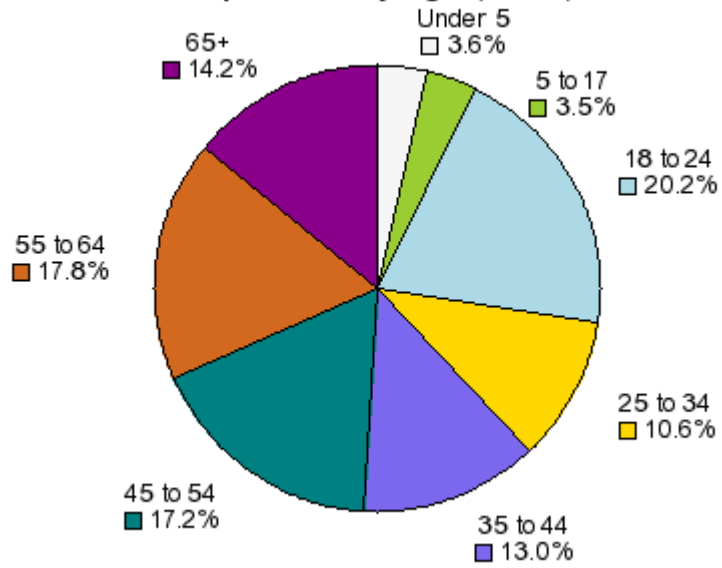

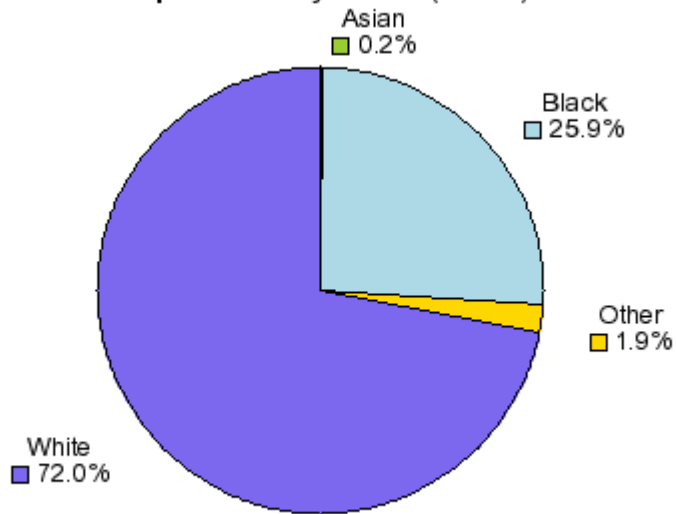

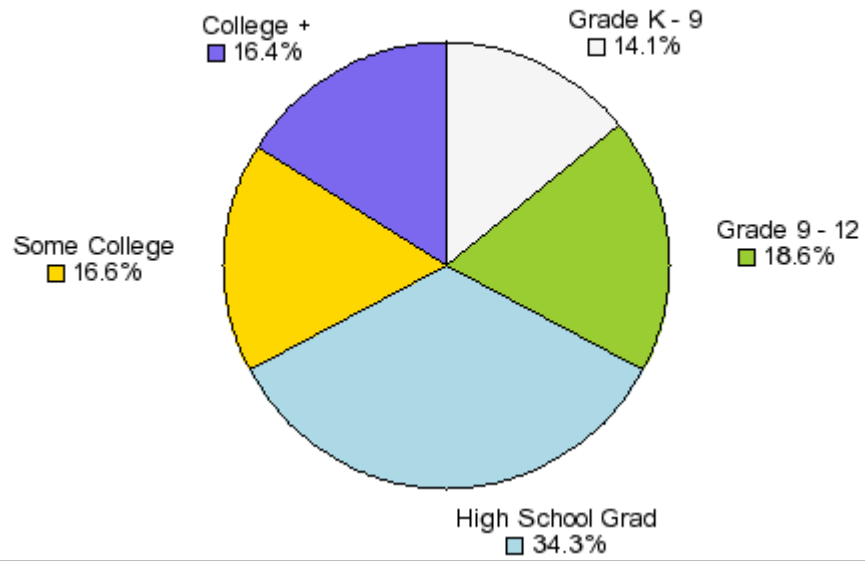
Population by Age (2003)



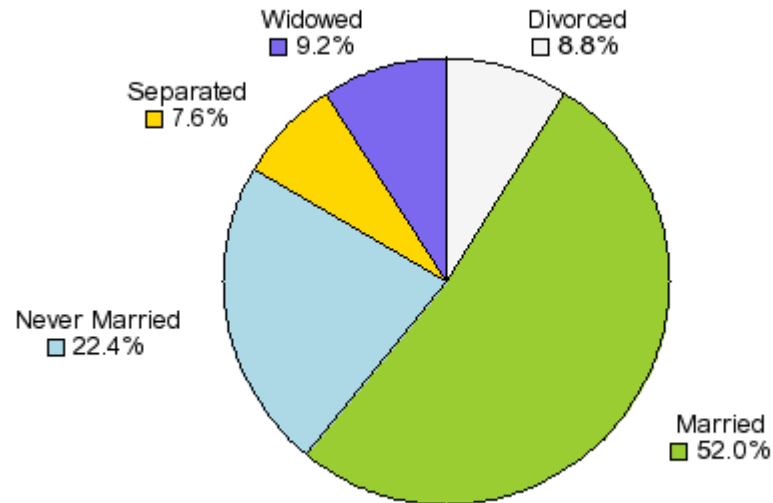
Population by Race (2003)

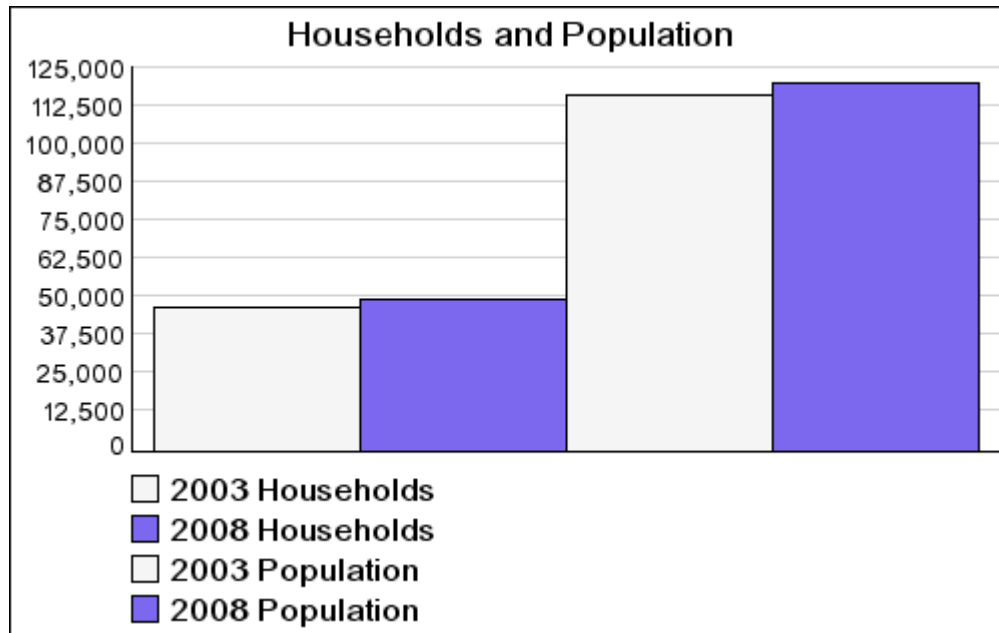


Education (2003)
