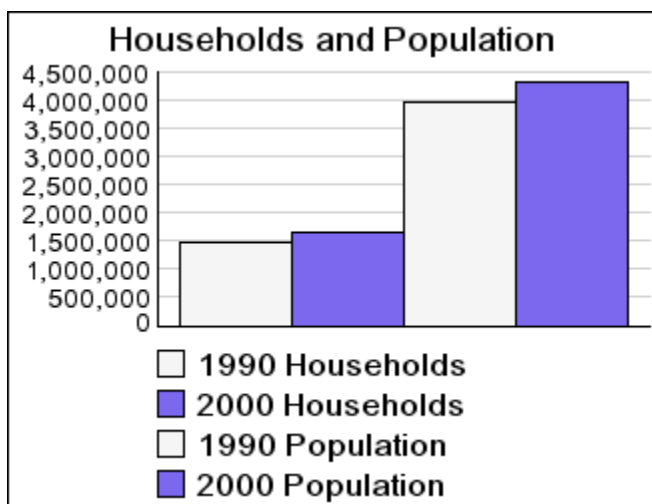

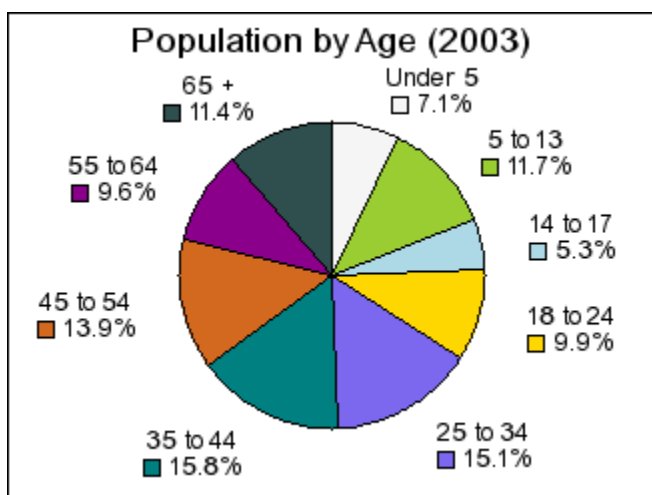
Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **1,499,581** and changed to **1,679,785** in 2000, representing a change of **12%**. The household count in 2003 was **1,751,156** and the household projection for 2008 is **1,863,115**, a change of **6%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **3,971,181** and in 2000 it was **4,340,477**, roughly a **9%** change. The population in 2003 was **4,484,401** and the projection for 2008 is **4,706,143** representing a change of **5%**.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **31.8**, and in 2000, it was **34.5**. The median age in 2003 is **35.5** and it is predicted to change in five years to **37.0** years.

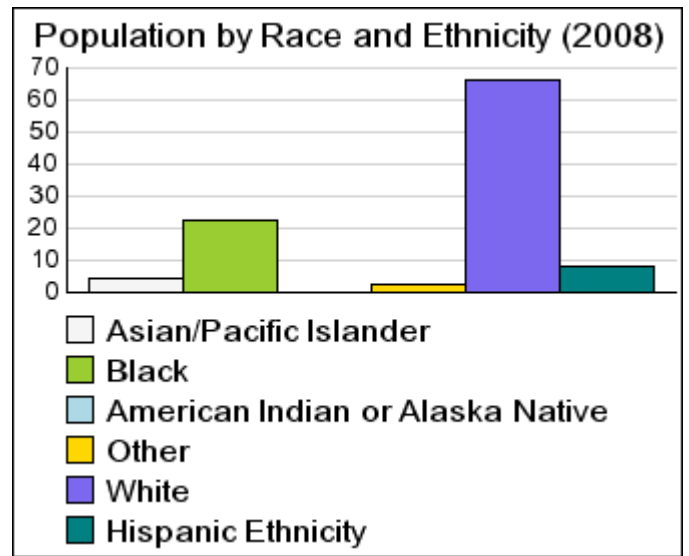
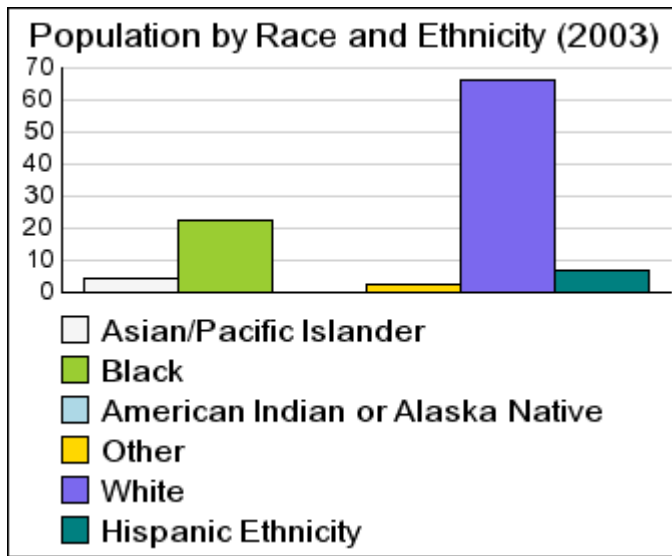
In 2003, females represented **51.2%** of the population with a median age of **36.9** and males represented **48.8%** of the population with a median age of **34.1** years.

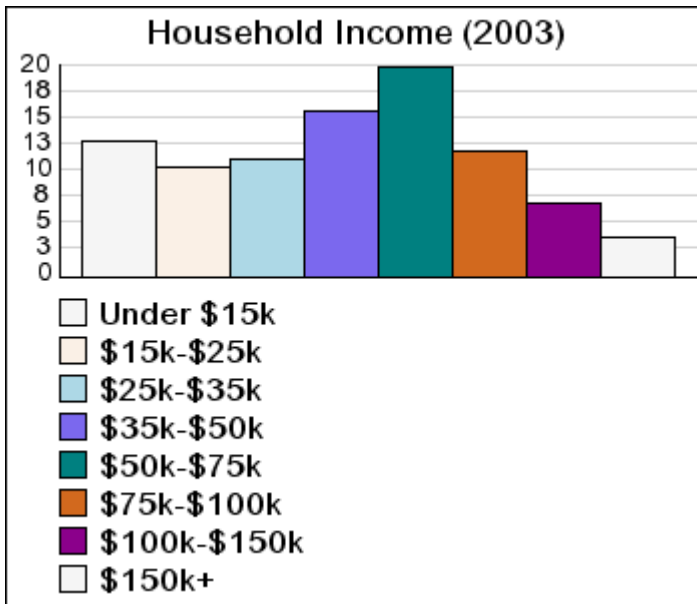
Population by Race/Ethnicity

Households by Income

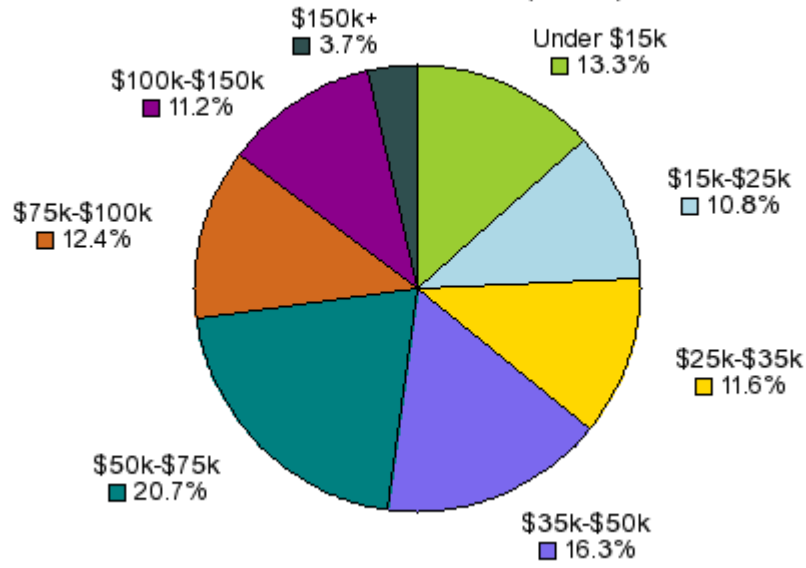

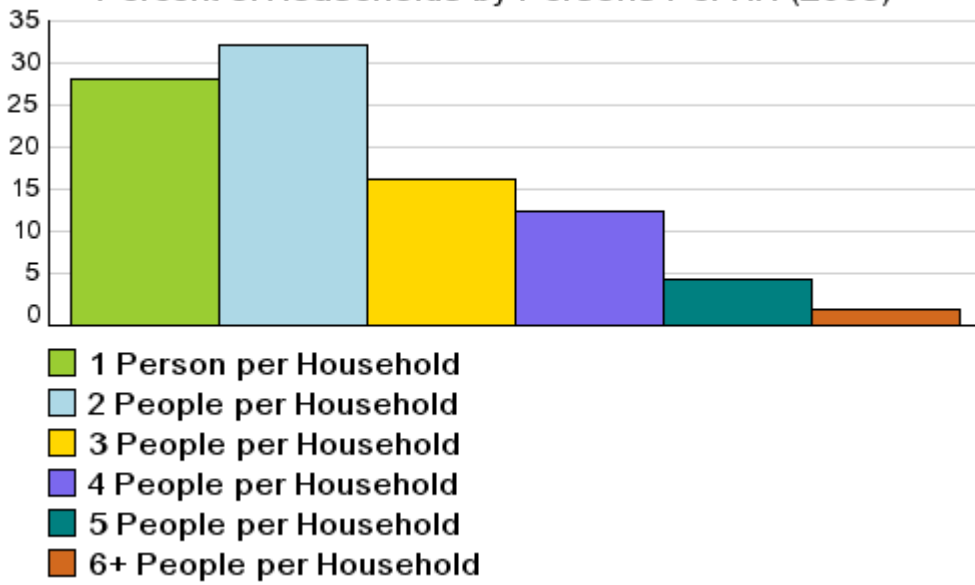

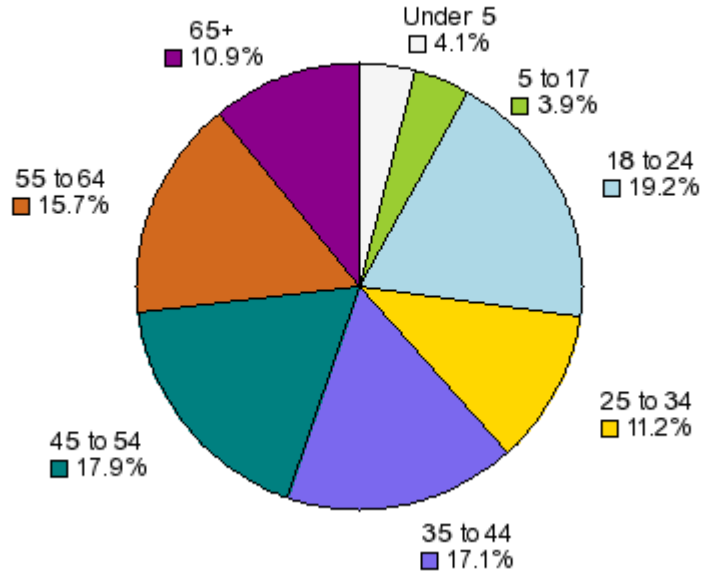
Household Income (2003)



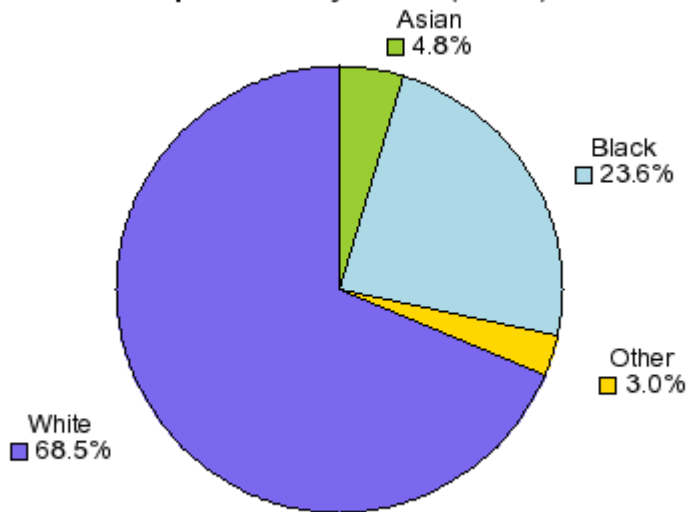
Percent of Households by Persons Per HH (2003)



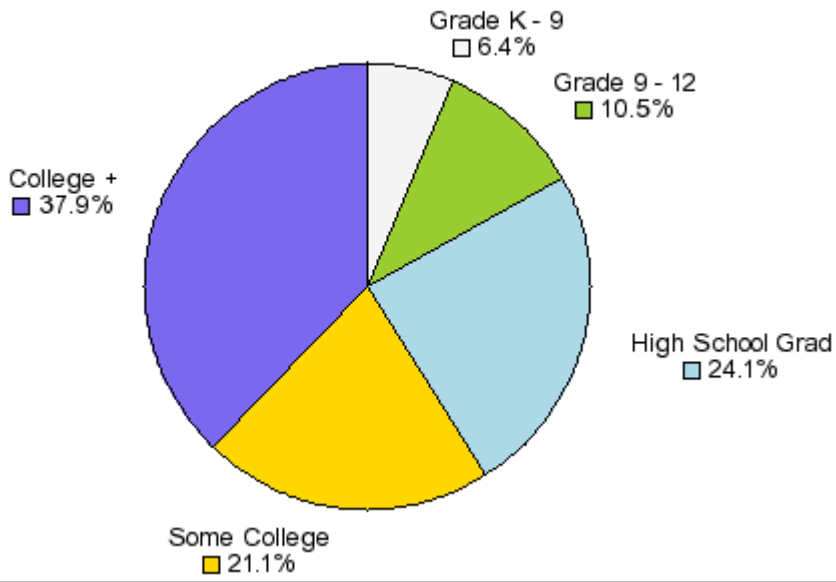
Population by Age (2003)



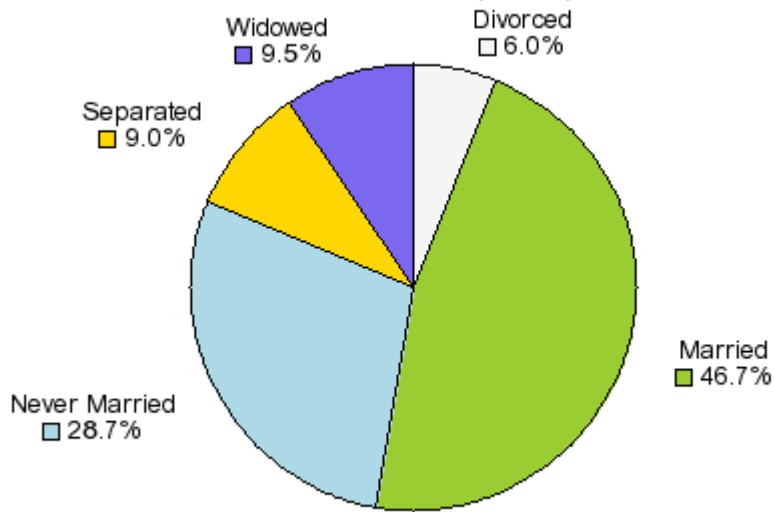
Population by Race (2003)

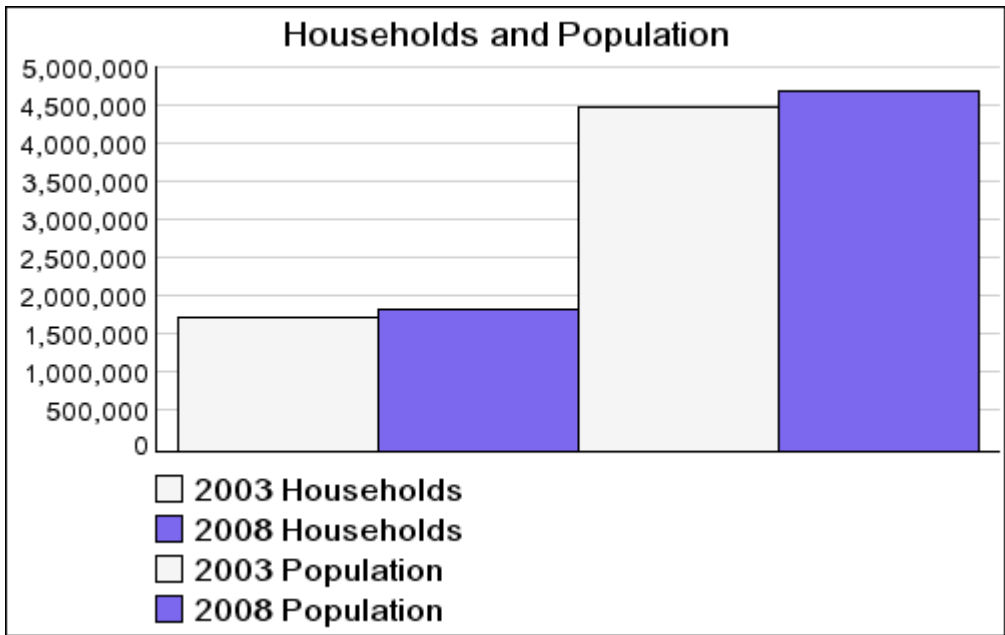


Education (2003)
