- Debbie Snead stated that Michelle Adcock accepted a lateral transfer position to Montgomery County to serve as 4-H Extension Agent. She will be missed greatly as a person and as an Extension Agent.
- Robert Roberts presented the home pages of the new web site. Team members were able to review and comment on each page and make necessary changes based on appropriateness and legal content. The site is to become live on Wednesday, October 1, 2003. Additional resources will be provided to Robert for posting. This information will also be reviewed by the team.
- Robert Roberts stated that BEV will begin implementing Community Readiness Seminars for assisting the team and local citizens in securing resources and maintaining web sites. Profit and non-profit organizations will be able to post and maintain their own pages following training and completion of the site (home page and links).
- Adele Morris will serve as webmaster for the county with support from the team. She will oversee the overall site as well as approve individual, group, and business postings.
- Technical support will be provided by BEV through June 2005. At that time, the county is to provide leadership and support.
- Individuals and organizations (non-profit) must register with the Electronic Villager Registration and set up a community connection account to pay \$20.00 annually in order to remain on the site. Eventually they will receive a password to access their pages for updates.
- Businesses (for profit) may continue to be listed, but must create their own home page and be linked to the Craig site. The site and all pages will continue to reside on the BEV server.
- The team will continue to meet on the fourth Monday of each month with the exception of holidays. The scheduling for the remaining year is as follows: October 27, November 24, and December 15. If the schools are closed for inclement weather, the meeting will be cancelled.
